4.28.010 **Airport Authority Created; Duties.**

There is hereby created an Airport Authority of the City of Lincoln, the authority to be a body politic and corporate, with duties and powers as set forth in the Cities Airport Authorities Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 3-201, 3-239, 3-501 to 3-514, and amendments thereto. (Ord. 15435 §1; February 12, 1990: P.C. §13.04.010: Ord. 6979 §1; August 3, 1959).

4.28.020 **Utility Service Charges; Electric Energy and Water.**

Charges for electric energy and water used and sold to persons, firms, and corporations located at Lincoln Municipal Airport shall be and they hereby are fixed as the same charges made for like services without the corporate limits of the City of Lincoln. 4.28.030 **Utility Service Charges; Heat, Switching Cars, Etc.**

Charges for heat, for switching cars, and for any other services performed by the city for which a charge is made, shall be fixed from time to time by resolution of the City Council. (Ord. 15435 §3; February 12, 1990: P.C. §13.16.020: Ord. 4246 §2; June 9, 1947).

4.28.040 **Parking; Regulation by Resolution.**

The City Council may, by resolution, set aside, restrict and regulate the use of the city-owned grounds adjacent to the Air Terminal Building of Lincoln Municipal Airport for the parking of such type or class of vehicle as is designated in such resolution. 4.28.050 **Illegal Parking; Impounding Vehicles.**

When any area is set aside for the parking of vehicles of a certain designated class or type as hereinbefore provided, it shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle other than a vehicle of the type or class specified in such restricted area, and any vehicle found parked in violation of this chapter may be impounded by the Chief of Police as provided in Title 10 of the Lincoln Municipal Code.
