

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

1           AN ORDINANCE amending Section 12.08.270 of the Lincoln Municipal Code  
 2 relating to alcoholic liquor in parks to allow alcohol to be served in conjunction with an event  
 3 sponsored by or to benefit the Parks and Recreation Department on the premises of Hazel Abel Park,  
 4 Stransky Park, Sunken Gardens, Antelope Park Rose Garden and Pioneers Park Nature Center; and  
 5 repealing Section 12.08.270 of the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto existing.

6           BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

7           Section 1. That Section 12.08.270 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be amended to  
 8 read as follows:

9       **12.08.270    Alcoholic Liquor Prohibited; Exceptions and Permit Requirements.**

10           It shall be unlawful for any person to consume or to possess any alcoholic liquor in any park;  
 11 provided, however, the above prohibition shall not apply to the following as they may be properly  
 12 licensed or permitted according to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act:

13           (a)    The retail licensed premises consisting of the clubhouse area of golf courses and  
 14 outdoor areas of any 18-hole golf course; and the

15           (b)    The premises of the Folsom Children’s Zoo and the Lincoln Children’s Museum in  
 16 conjunction with fundraising activities occurring when the zoo or museum are not otherwise open  
 17 to the public; and

18           (c)    The premises of Hazel Abel Park, Stransky Park, Sunken Gardens, Antelope Park  
 19 Rose Garden, and Pioneers Park Nature Center, in conjunction with fundraising activities sponsored  
 20 by and for the Parks and Recreation Department or by non-profit organizations specifically

1 organized to benefit the Parks and Recreation Department. Fundraising activities shall be allowed  
2 to occur only where the premises or the area of the activity is not otherwise open to the public.

3 Section 2. That Section 12.08.270 of the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto existing  
4 be and the same is hereby repealed.

5 Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
6 passage and publication according to law.
