TITLE: Resolution to approve awarding the contract to the low bidder for the agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads for the 27th Street viaduct repair project, State Project No. LCLC-5231(13), CN 13137. City Project No. 540023.

REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To provide authority for the Mayor to sign the contract for the 27th Street viaduct repair project. This resolution states that the City concurs with awarding the contract to the lowest bidder. The agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads (NDOR) allows the use of Federal Transportation Program Funds for construction and construction engineering for the repair of the 27th Street viaduct.

D I S C U S S I O N

The City of Lincoln (City) receives an annual apportionment of Federal Surface Transportation funds (STP) administrated by the Nebraska Department of Roads. The programming agreement for this project was executed in November 22, 2010.

The low bid came in at \$1,980,911. The only other bid received on this project was \$2,358,230. The Engineer's estimate was \$1,941,300. In reviewing the bids with NDOR, we believe this to be a good bid and recommend moving ahead with the 27th Street viaduct improvements. The cost split will be 80% federal funds and 20% local funds.
