The City of Lincoln (City) proposes to replace the existing 48<sup>th</sup> & Hwy 2 signal which is nearing its service life. The City and Olsson Associates wish to enter into an agreement which establishes the scope and fee for environmental services for this project to comply with NEPA regulations. The State agrees to use the City's Federal Transportation Funds up to 80% of the actual cost of federal aid eligible items for this contract.
