HARDSHIP: Chapter 6: 020.04:

Where a license has been issued and the licensee finds that the licensee will not be able to maintain continuous operation during the license year as a result of fire, tornado, flood, loss of lease or some other reason constituting a hardship the licensee shall apply to the Commission within thirty days of the occurrence constituting hardship for permission to voluntarily cease operations and maintain the licensee's license for a period of time not to exceed the end of the licensed year for which the license was issued. Any such status afforded shall be reviewable by the Commission within sixty days of the end of any license year in which such status has been afforded. Failure to afford such status or the revision of such status shall subject the licensee to an Order of the Commission to show cause why the licensee's license should not be cancelled.

Please be advised that the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission (NLCC) has administratively granted your request to place the above referenced liquor license in a hardship status until October 31st, 2015 due to a fire.

This administrative approval of hardship status will be presented to the Commission for ratification at the next scheduled hearing.


