## DISCUSSION

The South Beltway will replace Nebr. Hwy 2 between 127<sup>th</sup> Street & Hwy 77 on the National Highway System. It will provide a connection between US Hwy 77 at the west and Nebr. Hwy 2 at the southeast edge of Lincoln. The project is also expected to incorporate Intelligent Transportation System (ITS).
