The Public Works and Utilities Department has received a request for a use of public right-of-way for the installation of a private 6" chilled water supply line and a 6" chilled water return line to serve the Nebraska State Historical Museum at Centennial Mall and "P" Street. This action would allow the replacement of the HVAC system in the State Museum.

The state's contractor will be required to contact Diggers Hot Line of Nebraska at 1-800-331-5666 prior to commencing any construction activities. Proposed lines will occupy approximately 3,495 square feet.
