

ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 AN ORDINANCE creating Water District No. _____, designating the real estate to be
 2 benefitted, providing for assessment of the costs of the improvements constructed therein,
 3 providing for the acquisition of easements and additional right-of-way, if necessary, and repealing
 4 all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

5 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

6 Section 1. That Water District No. ____ is hereby created for the purpose of constructing
 7 an 6-inch diameter water main or mains in Northwest 6th from West Dawes to West Saunders, in
 8 the City of Lincoln.

9 Section 2. The district shall include benefitted real estate described as follows: a portion
 10 of Lot 2, and all of Lots 3 and 4, Block 13 in West Lincoln Addition to Lincoln; all located in the
 11 Northeast Quarter of Section 15, Township 10, North Range 6 East of the Sixth Principal
 12 Meridian , in the City of Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska. .

13 Section 3. The cost of the constructing said water mains, including the cost of fire plugs,
 14 valves, and all other expenses incidental to said improvements, shall be assessed against the
 15 benefitted real estate within the district, not exceeding the special benefits accruing on account
 16 thereof. In the event that easements or additional right-of-way must be acquired for the
 17 completion of this district, such property rights may be acquired by negotiation and purchase or
 18 by condemnation, if necessary, as provided by law.

19 Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same
 20 are hereby repealed.

1 Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and
2 publication according to law, but construction shall not be commenced until ordered by resolution
3 by the City Council.
