TITLE: Request for use of right-of-way for installation of a 4" electric conduit under North 14th Street between "Q" and "R" Streets.

REASON FOR LEGISLATION: Installation of a 4" electric conduit under North 14th Street between "Q" and "R" Streets. Conduit is for fiber optic communication.

D I S C U S S I O N

The Department of Public Works and Utilities has received a request for the University of Nebraska-Lincoln for the installation of a 4" electric conduit under North 14th Street between "Q" and "R" Streets. This conduit would provide for fiber optic communication to the University of Nebraska Cultural Center located at 333 North 14th Street. This request complies with Chapter 14.53 of the Lincoln Municipal Code.

The City of Lincoln Wastewater Division has an existing sanitary sewer adjacent to this location. Alltel and the City of Lincoln Water System also has existing facilities in the area. The City of Lincoln Parks Department commented that an existing planter is located 10 feet north of the proposed conduit and has requested that the root system for existing trees not be disturbed. The University of Nebraska's contractor is required to contact Diggers Hot Line of Nebraska at 1-800-331-5666 prior to commencing construction.

The Department of Public Works and Utilities recommends approval of this request with the above conditions. Area of proposed use of right-of-way is 140 linear feet, more or less.
