REASON FOR LEGISLATION: Request for use of right-of-way from the University of Nebraska to place a 4" telecommunications conduit under a portion of the abandoned Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way and North 18th Street located in Northwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 10 North, Range 6 East, for the purpose of providing fiber optic communication to the recently acquired Cushman main plant building located at 900 North 21st Street.

D I S C U S S I O N

The Public Works and Utilities Department has received a request for a use of public right-of-way for the installation of a 4" telecommunications conduit under a portion of the abandoned Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way and North 18th Street. Purpose of the request is providing fiber optic communication to the recently acquired Cushman main plant building located at 900 North 21st Street.

The location of the proposed conduit was planned around the proposed alignment of the Antelope Valley Roadway. The City of Lincoln Parks Department has requested a set of as-built plans following completion of this conduit. The University's contractor will be required to contact Diggers Hotline of Nebraska prior to commencing construction activities.
