

ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 AN ORDINANCE amending Section 17.30.050 of the Lincoln Municipal Code
 2 relating to Discontinuance of Water Service to correct an erroneous reference to Section 17.22.095
 3 found in subsection (b) of Section 27.30.050 to correctly refer to Section 17.22.100; and repealing
 4 Section 17.30.050 of the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto existing.

5 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

6 Section 1. That Section 17.30.050 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be amended to read
 7 as follows:

8 **17.30.050 Conference; Employee; Duties.**

9 Upon notice to the employee designated by the Lincoln Water System of any request for a
 10 conference by a domestic subscriber, the employee shall:

11 (a) Notify the domestic subscriber, in writing, of the time, place, and date scheduled for the
 12 conference; and

13 (b) Hold a conference within fourteen days of the receipt of the domestic subscriber's
 14 request. Such conference shall be informal and not governed by the Nebraska Rules of Evidence. If
 15 the employee determines at the conference that the domestic subscriber did not receive proper notice
 16 or was denied any other right afforded under this chapter or Sections 17.22.090 and ~~17.22.095~~
 17 17.22.100, the employee shall recess and continue the conference at such time as the subscriber has
 18 been afforded his or her rights. Failure of a domestic subscriber to attend a scheduled conference
 19 shall relieve the Lincoln Water System of any further action prior to the discontinuance of service.
 20 If a domestic subscriber shall contact the Lincoln Water System prior to the scheduled conference

1 and demonstrate that failure to attend was for a legitimate reason, the Lincoln Water System shall
2 make a reasonable effort to reschedule the conference.

3 Section 2. That Section 17.30.050 of the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto existing
4 be and the same is hereby repealed.

5 Section 3. Pursuant to Article VII, Section 7 of the City Charter, this ordinance shall
6 be posted on the official bulletin board of the City in lieu of and in place of newspaper publication
7 with notice of passage and such posting to be given by publication one time in the official newspaper
8 by the City Clerk. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and
9 publication as herein and in the City Charter provided.
