TITLE: Resolution to approve an Interlocal Agreement for cost sharing of a Drainage Structure on NW 70th Street.

APPLICANT: Public Works & Utilities and Lower Platte South Natural Resource District

REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To provide authority for the City to reimburse the Lower Platte South Natural Resource District to build a longer drainage culvert through their proposed dam on NW 70th Street between West Adams and West Superior Streets.

D I S C U S S I O N

This area of NW 70th between West Superior Street and West Adams Street is included in the Comprehensive Plan as Tier One Priority A & Tier Two Urban Growth Areas. The County is planning to grade and pane this street in the near future and the NRD has plans to build a flood control structure as well. Even though the City has no plans to build this street as an urban street in the 6-Year CIP, NW 70th is in the LRTP 2030 roadway improvements as a future Urban 2+ Turn Lane Roadway with 120 R.O.W. As such, the City requested the District & County to relocate and redesign the structure off the section line to allow room for a future urban roadway section. Part of that flood control structure design includes extending the outflow pipe beyond the future road and constructing the outlet structure so that it would not need to be removed and rebuilt by the City in the future, which would cost significantly more then doing it now. The District will extend the pipe now and build the outflow structure and only bill the City for the extra pipe length required plus engineering.
