

ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 AN ORDINANCE amending Section 21.48.030 of the Lincoln Municipal Code
 2 relating to penalties for violations of the Lincoln Housing Code to increase the fine for first offenses
 3 from \$25.00 to \$200.00, for second offenses from \$50.00 to \$250.00, and for third offenses and each
 4 offense thereafter from \$100.00 to \$300.00; and repealing Section 21.48.030 of the Lincoln
 5 Municipal Code as hitherto existing.

6 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

7 Section 1. That Section 21.48.030 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be amended to
 8 read as follows:

9 **21.48.030 Penalty For Violations.**

10 Any person upon whom a duty is placed by the provisions of this title who shall fail, neglect,
 11 or refuse to perform such duty, or who shall violate any of the provisions of this title, shall be
 12 deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed
 13 \$500.00 or be imprisoned in the county jail for a period not to exceed six months, or both, except
 14 that each person so convicted shall be fined in a sum of not less than ~~twenty-five dollars~~ \$200.00
 15 for the first offense, not less than ~~fifty dollars~~ \$250.00 for a second offense, and not less than
 16 ~~\$100.00~~ \$300.00 for the third offense and each offense thereafter. The penalty herein provided shall
 17 be cumulative with and in addition to the revocation, cancellation, or forfeiture of any license,
 18 permit, or right elsewhere provided for violation thereof or as provided by law. Each day that a
 19 violation of this title continues shall constitute a separate and distinct offense and shall be punishable
 20 as such.

1 Section 2. That Section 21.48.030 of the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto
2 existing be and the same is hereby repealed.

3 Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
4 passage and publication according to law.
