REASON FOR LEGISLATION:

To formally recognize the Little Salt Creek revised 100-year Floodprone Area and Floodway as the best available information for local flood regulation purposes.

DISCUSSION

This is a resolution to formally recognize the revised Floodprone Area and Floodway of Little Salt Creek, as shown on the revised attached map, as the best available information for local regulatory purposes, in conformance with the Flood Standards for Existing Urban Areas and New Growth Areas. The earlier map associated with Resolution A-85517 (Bill Number 09R-162, Public Hearing date September 21, 2009) had an error with the floodway near the confluence with Salt Creek. This resolution seeks to correct that error.

POLICY OR PROGRAM CHANGE: No. This resolution conforms with the Flood Standards for Existing Urban Areas and New Growth Areas.
