The July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, budget for the Railroad Transportation Safety District approved \$600,000 for the Quiet Zone – 14<sup>th</sup> & Yankee Hill for the 2010-11 year as identified on the flow of funds statement.

These funds will be used for the construction of railroad-roadway crossing safety improvements necessary to create a Quiet Zone.
