## **F A C T S H E E T**

**TITLE:** Lincoln Downtown Street Resurfacing Project, State Project No. LCLC-5230(2), CN 13140; City Project No. 540021

**SPONSOR:** Public Works and Utilities

**APPLICANT:** Public Works and Utilities

**REASON FOR LEGISLATION:** To provide authority for the Mayor to execute a Funding Agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads, so that the identified project will be eligible for Federal Surface Transportation Program Funds and used for the construction and construction engineering of this street rehabilitation project in Downtown Lincoln.

## **DISCUSSION**

The City of Lincoln Public Works and Utilities proposes to resurface approximately 6 miles on 11 city streets in Downtown Lincoln. The project will also include minor base repair and replacement of curb ramps and sidewalk panels that do not meet ADA standards. Replacement of the traffic signals at the intersections of Q Street and 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> and the intersections of N Street and 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and Centennial Mall is also included. One location, K Street, may require widening to meet current minimum lane width standards. The construction and construction engineering will be partially funded (80%) by Federal Surface Transportation Program funds currently estimated to be \$4,380,000. The City will pay 100% of the preliminary engineering costs and 20% of the construction and construction engineering costs, currently estimated to be \$1,245,000 total. Please see the attached list for project locations. The completion of this improvement is anticipated in 2012.
