To update the existing Interlocal agreement with Lancaster County for how Information Services provides services to the County and City. This updated agreement is meant to accomplish the following:

1. Provide the Information Services Policy Committee (ISPC) with more flexibility to create and/or retire Advisory Groups.
2. Emphasize the ISPC role on cost allocation and rate-setting.
3. Introduce the concept of Enterprise Projects, including greater ISPC oversight of such projects.
4. Refine language pertaining to termination and dissolution of assets.
5. Update language to reflect more contemporary Information Technology vocabulary.
