DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

The City of Lincoln and Lincoln Electric System wish to enter into an agreement which establish the responsibilities and fees for the relocation of electrical distribution facilities for safety improvements at the intersection of Coddington Avenue and West Van Dorn Street in the City of Lincoln. The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has agreed to provide safety funds to cover 90% of the total project costs with the City providing the remaining 10%.
