REASON FOR LEGISLATION

To provide authority for the Mayor to execute a Funding Agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads (NDOR), so that Federal Funds can be used to complete the Fracture Critical Bridge Inspection of the East leg of the Big 'X', the eastbound Rosa Parks bridge, and a bridge for access to City of Lincoln property at the Ashland Water Treatment Plant.

DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

Federal-Aid Bridge Replacement Funds have been made available through the Nebraska Department of Roads Statewide Fracture Critical Bridge Inspection Program to pay for 80% of the eligible cost associated with the inspection of Fracture Critical Bridges. By entering into this agreement with NDOR, Federal-Aid Funds can be used to pay for 80% of the eligible engineering for bridge inventory, inspection and classification costs. The City's share is currently estimated to be \$1,846.99 but may increase or decrease due to variations between the estimated and actual project costs. Should the City elect not to participate in this program, the City is responsible for 100% of the costs to complete the Fracture Critical Bridge Inspections. This inspection is required every 24 months by the National Bridge Inspection Standards (NBIS) and NDOR.


