BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

Section 1. That the former University Place City Hall located at 2601 North 48<sup>th</sup>

Street, on property legally described as: Lots 1-3, Winters Subdivision, located in the Northwest

Quarter of Section 17, Township 10 North, Range 7 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Lincoln, Lancaster

County, Nebraska, be and it hereby is designated as a Landmark under Section 27.57.120 of the Lincoln Municipal Code.

Section 2. Notwithstanding the existing zoning on the property or the other rules and regulations of Title 27 of the Lincoln Municipal code, there are hereby established Guidelines for Preservation of the above described property as stated in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully set forth herein.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published, within fifteen days after the passage hereof, in one issue of a daily or weekly newspaper of general circulation in the City, or posted on the official bulletin board of the City, located on the wall across from the City Clerk's office at 555 S. 10<sup>th</sup> Street, in lieu and in place of the foregoing newspaper publication with notice of passage and such posting to be given by publication one time in the official newspaper by the City Clerk. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication or after its posting and notice of such posting given by publication as herein and in the City Charter provided.
