

RESOLUTION NO. A-_____

WHEREAS, Resolution No. A-75378 provides that five percent of the gross proceeds realized by the City of Lincoln from the operation of a keno lottery shall be designated for such human services as may be recommended and approved by the Joint Budget Committee, City Council and Lancaster Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Budget Committee has recommended that the City Council and Lancaster County Board of Commissioners approve \$5,000 for Nebraska AIDS Project; and

WHEREAS, the City portion of this funding would amount to \$2,500; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that such funding be restricted and spent only on material for the work place which raises awareness of the local adult community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

The designation of the \$2,500 from gross funds from the operation of keno lottery for the Nebraska AIDS Project that is restricted for use only for material for the work place which raises awareness of AIDS in the local adult community is hereby approved and the Mayor is authorized to enter into grant contracts with Lancaster County, Nebraska and the Nebraska AIDS Project as authorized by this Resolution.
