WHEREAS, the Planning Director has made application to amend the 1994 Lincoln City-Lancaster County Comprehensive Plan to change approximately 20 acres of land generally located at the southwest corner of 98th and Cornhusker Highway from Agricultural to Industrial; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln City-Lancaster County Planning Commission has made recommendations on said proposed change and has recommended approval of said proposed change.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

That the Lincoln City-Lancaster County Comprehensive Plan (1994) be and the same is hereby amended to revise Figure 16 (Lincoln's Land Use Plan, page 39) and Figure 17 (Lancaster County's Land Use Plan, page 41) to change the Future Land Use of property generally located at the southwest corner of 98th Street and Cornhusker Highway from Agricultural to Industrial as shown the map, excluding the area recommended to remain agricultural, which is attached hereto as Attachment AA@.
