

ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 AN ORDINANCE creating Alley Paving District No. ____, defining the limits thereof,
2 establishing the width of the roadway to be paved and the width of the grading to be done,
3 providing for the curbing, guttering, and relaying of sidewalks, providing for the payment of the
4 cost thereof, designating the property to be benefited, providing for the acquisition of easements
5 and additional right-of-way, if necessary, and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in
6 conflict herewith.

7 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

8 Section 1. That Alley Paving District No. ____, of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska, be and
9 the same is hereby created; that said Alley Paving District shall include all that portion of the
10 East/West Alley, 47th St. to 48th St., Lowell Ave. To Prescott Ave, in said City, and the
11 following described real estate benefited, to-wit: Block 32, Lots 1 - 12, College View all located
12 in the Southwest Quarter of Section 5, Township 9 North, Range 7 East of the 6th Principal
13 Meridian in the City of Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska.

14 The roadway to be paved in said District shall be 16 feet in width; grading to be from
15 lot line to lot line, and the cost of grading, curbing, guttering, and paving the same, including the
16 cost of grading, curbing, guttering and paving the intersections and returns, and the cost of
17 grading the sidewalk space and relaying of sidewalks and all expenses incidental to all of said
18 improvements shall be assessed against the property benefited in said District in proportion to the
19 benefits, not exceeding the cost thereof. In the event that easements or additional right-of-way
20 must be acquired for the completion of this district, such property rights may be acquired by
21 negotiation and purchase or by condemnation, if necessary, as provided by law.

1 Section 2. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same
2 hereby are repealed.

3 Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and
4 publication according to law, but construction shall not be commenced until ordered by resolution
by the City Council.
