The location of the bank is in the vicinity of the City's South Wellfield in Ashland. The City would benefit from the stabilization of this bank. The funding for the project is proposed to be shared by 3 parties; Lincoln, Lower Platte South NRD, and Willow Point Homeowners Association. The City's share of the cost is \$24,713.73.
