**AGREEMENT**

REGISTERED IN THE OFFICE OF

This Agreement is entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 2000, by and between the County of Lancaster, Nebraska ("County"), the City of Lincoln, Nebraska ("City"), and the United Way of Lincoln and Lancaster County ("United Way"), (collectively referred to as "the parties"), for the purpose of defining the parties' participation in the funding of the implementation of the Community-Based Human Services Needs Assessment and Comprehensive Plan.

WHEREAS, NEB.REV.STAT. § 13-801 *et seq.* (Reissue 1997) permits units of local government in the State of Nebraska to cooperate with one another for the purpose of jointly exercising governmental authority and responsibilities they share in common; and

WHEREAS, the County previously entered into a contract with the University of Nebraska Public Policy Center ("Public Policy Center"), for the purpose of implementing the Community-Based Human Services Needs Assessment (Needs Assessment). A copy of said contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the City and the United Way will utilize the Implementation Plan in determining how to best meet the human services needs of the City of Lincoln and Lancaster County communities; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to participate as equal partners in funding the Needs Assessment and Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the County's contract with the Public Policy Center, is divided into two phases: Phase I (Infrastructure Development) and Phase II (Implementation Plan); and

WHEREAS, the contract with the Public Policy Center requires payment from the County in an amount not to exceed Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$75,000). This contract is for eight months in preparation for a second 16-month ongoing contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

1. Funding of Phase I and Phase II. The City, County and Untied Way shall each contribute 1/3 of the contract fee for Phase I. Each party's funding of Phase I shall not exceed the following:

County — Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$25,000)  
City — Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$25,000)

United Way — Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$25,000)

2. Additional Funding: Pursuant to the County's contract with the Public Policy Center, payment to the Public Policy Center for its services may exceed the amounts stated in its contract only upon prior written authorization from the County. The United Way and the City will not be responsible for any additional costs authorized by the County unless they have agreed to such increases in writing. Any additional costs shall be divided equally among the County, City and United Way, unless otherwise agreed by the parties.
3. Payment: Upon accepted reports to the Steering Committee every two months, the County shall provide Eighteen Thousand Seven Hundred-Fifty Dollars and No Cents (\$18,750), not to exceed Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$75,000) to the Public Policy Center. The City and United Way shall reimburse the County for their portion as requested.


