**REASON FOR LEGISLATION:** To encumber Federal Highway Safety Funds for reconstructing the intersection of 33rd & Sheridan Blvd. as a "Roundabout."

Reconstruct the 33rd & Sheridan Signalized intersection in Lincoln to provide a concrete roundabout. The roundabout is expected to improve overall safety of this intersection, which has been ranked as one of the high accident intersections.
