REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To enter into an agreement with the State of Nebraska Department of Roads for the purpose of analyzing the alignment of Highway US-6 (Sun Valley Boulevard) from West 'O' Street north to Cornhusker Highway.

D I S C U S S I O N

The State of Nebraska Dept. of Roads in collaboration with the City of Lincoln is undertaking a location and feasibility study, which will evaluate the improvement of Highway US-6 along the existing corridor or the realignment of Sun Valley Boulevard, from approximately Westgate Boulevard north to Cornhusker Highway at 1st Street.

POLICY OR PROGRAM CHANGE: None

COST OF TOTAL PROJECT: Estimated cost \$150,000.

SOURCE OF FUNDS:

CITY: Street Construction (Misc. Subarea Studies)
Local participation will equal \$30,000 (20%) maximum.

NON CITY: Federal/State share shall equal \$120,000 (80% of \$150,000)

BENEFIT COST: To be determined utilizing results from the study.
