**REASON FOR LEGISLATION:** This agreement provides for City participation in maintenance work on Highway 2 between 9th Street and Highway 77.

## DISCUSSION

The City has been asked to fund a portion of the maintenance work proposed for Highway 2 between 9th Street and Highway 77. This agreement provides that the Nebraska Department of Roads will perform the work, diamond grinding, (work similar to that recently performed on Highway 77) and the City will fund \$17,000 of the estimated \$411,000 total cost of the work.

## A G R E E M E N T

PROJECT NO. RD-2-6(1022), STATE CONTROL NO. 12551  
CITY OF LINCOLN  
STATE OF NEBRASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ROADS  
DIAMOND GRINDING

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into between the City of Lincoln, hereinafter referred to as the "City", and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads, hereinafter referred to as the "State",

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the State has plans for the improvement of Highway N-2, from Highway US-77 to 9<sup>th</sup> Street in Lincoln, under Project No. RD-2-6(1022), and

WHEREAS, the City has requested that the State "diamond grind" the east and westbound driving lanes from 1<sup>st</sup> Street to 9<sup>th</sup> Street in Lincoln, and

WHEREAS, the State is willing to perform the above said diamond grinding, and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to reimburse the State for 100 percent of the actual cost the said diamond grinding.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of these facts, the parties hereto agree as follows:

SECTION 1. The State, as a part of Project No. RD-2-6(1022), diamond grind the east and west driving lanes of Highway N-2 from 1<sup>st</sup> Street to 9<sup>th</sup> Street in Lincoln.

SECTION 2. The City agrees to pay for 100 percent of the actual cost of the diamond grinding of Highway N-2 from 1<sup>st</sup> Street to 9<sup>th</sup> Street in Lincoln. Thirty days prior to construction work beginning, the State will bill the City for 100 percent of the amount reflected in the construction contract for the above said diamond grinding. The City's share is currently estimated to be \$17,000.00; however, such costs may increase or decrease due to variations between the estimated project costs and the actual project costs. Should the cost of the diamond grinding overrun or underrun the contract amount, the City will be billed or be reimbursed for such overrun or underrun. The City agrees to pay the State within thirty days of a billing from the State.


