Mayor Wesely and Members of the City Council:

An investigation has been made regarding the application of Silver Spoke Saloon, 1031 'M' Street. Silver Spoke Saloon is requesting an addition to their current licensed premises, liquor license CK44164.

The additional area requested is their parking lot, which is located to the Northeast of the current liquor license.

Silver Spoke Saloon wishes the area to be licensed so it may be used as an occasional beer garden when fenced but to remain as a parking lot in the daytime hours.

The Lincoln Police Department recommends denial of this request due to the following.

1. All past approvals of outside permanent beer gardens a permanent fence has been required.
2. No other liquor license in the City of Lincoln has received approval for an addition to a liquor license with the above listed dual purposes.
3. If approved the applicant does not need Council approval for any future outside functions, and patrons could consume alcohol in the open lot which is not separate from the general public.
4. Request for occasional beer gardens are processed through the City Clerk, and are governed by the City Council. If approved this area would be governed by the State Liquor Control Commission.

If this application is approved, it should be with the understanding that it conforms to all the rules and regulations of Lincoln, Lancaster County and the State of Nebraska.
