D I S C U S S I O N

The petitioner is requesting that Orchard Street be paved. At this time Orchard Street between 40th Street and 41st Street is graveled and the petitioner will be building a house at this location and has concerns with dust and storm water drainage.

The intersections of 40th and of 41st and Orchard currently are paved which would allow this one block section of Orchard to be paved under the "Gap and extend law (Nebr. Rev. Stat. 18-200)".
