RE: Report of Claims Against the City of Lincoln for May 16 through 31, 2002

Dear Mayor & Council:

The following is a report of new and pending claims against the City of Lincoln, as well as claims which have been disposed of, for the period of May 16 through May 31, 2002. This report shall indicate the types of claims filed and the status and dispositions of these claims.

CLAIMS FILED IN PREVIOUS MONTHS:

Roland F. Bouska filed a claim during the month of September, 2000, in the amount of \$10,000 for alleged damages incurred as the result of an accident involving a Lincoln police vehicle. This claim has been referred to the City's fleet carrier and is **PENDING**.

William Mann filed a claim during the month of April, 2001, in the amount of \$25,000 for alleged damages incurred when claimant was a passenger in an ambulance that was involved in an accident. This claim has been referred to the City's fleet carrier and is **PENDING**.

The Estate of Connie McCullough, Michael McCullough, individually and as natural parent of Shane and Michelle McCullough, and Tom Grafton, Personal Representative of the Estate of Connie McCullough, filed a claim during the month of July, 2001, in an unspecified amount for damages arising from a motor vehicle accident wherein Anthony Waadah was driving on "O" Street during the 2000 Americruise event and collided with Connie McCullough who was along side the street watching the event with her two children. The claim alleges negligence by the City in failing to provide proper traffic control, failing to require a parade or special event permit, and failing to warn the public of the dangerous condition created by the excessive volume of cars participating in the Americruise event. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

County of Lancaster filed a claim during the month of October, 2001, for medical expenses incurred as the result of an arrest by Lincoln police of an individual who was taken to the hospital for treatment of injuries allegedly incurred during his arrest. The County alleges that they inadvertently paid for part of the medical expenses. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

Amy Bruning filed a claim during the month of December, 2001, in an unspecified amount for alleged injuries incurred as the result of a motor vehicle accident wherein claimant was a passenger in a vehicle that was in collision with a Lincoln police cruiser. This claim has been referred to the City's fleet carrier and is **PENDING**.

Allen Hall filed a claim during the month of February, 2002, in the amount of \$50,000 for alleged damages incurred as the result of an accident involving a City police cruiser. This claim has been referred to the City's fleet carrier. The claim is **PENDING**.

Jamestown Association filed a claim during the month of February, 2002, in an unspecified amount for damage incurred to sprinkler system as the result of snow removal. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

Heidi J. Burklund filed a claim during the month of February, 2002, in the amount of \$,1441.80 for alleged damage incurred to her vehicle while parked at Carriage Park Garage, a National Garages parking facility. This claim was referred to the insurer for the subject parking facility and has been **DENIED**.

Michael Harwood filed a claim during the month of February, 2002, in the amount of \$1,778.00 for alleged damage incurred as the result of a sanitary sewer back-up, which occurred as the result of the vandalism of the subject sanitary sewer line. This claim had previously been denied and denial was adopted by resolution of the City Council on March 18, 2002. Upon further review, this claim has now been **SETTLED** in the amount of \$1,250.00.

Karen Carder filed a claim during the month of February, 2002, in the amount of \$472.00 for alleged damage incurred as the result of a sanitary sewer back-up, which occurred as the result of the vandalism of the subject sanitary sewer line. This claim had previously been denied and denial was adopted by resolution of the City Council on March 18, 2002. Upon further review, this claim has now been **SETTLED** in the amount of \$330.00.

Richard C. Nesiba filed a claim during the month of February, 2002, in the amount of \$5,771.74 for alleged damage incurred to his rental property as the result of a sanitary sewer back-up, which occurred as the result of the vandalism of the subject sanitary sewer line. This claim had previously been denied and denial was adopted by resolution of the City Council on March 18, 2002. Upon further review, this claim has now been **SETTLED** in the amount of \$5,191.74.

Victor Gayed filed a claim during the month of February, 2002, in the amount of \$1,493.89 for alleged damage incurred to his rental property as the result of a sanitary sewer back-up, which occurred as the result of the vandalism of the subject sanitary sewer line. This claim had previously been denied and denial was adopted by resolution of the City Council on March 18, 2002. Upon further review, this claim has now been **SETTLED** in the amount of \$1,418.87.

Eugene L. Jones and Alice L. Jones (Jones Apartments) filed a claim during the month of March, 2002, in the amount of \$3,335.26 for alleged damage incurred to rental property as the result of a sanitary sewer back-up, which occurred as the result of the vandalism of the subject sanitary sewer line. This claim had previously been denied and denial was adopted by resolution of the City Council on April 1, 2002. Upon further review, this claim has now been **SETTLED** in the amount of \$3,015.26.

Patricia and James Dodson filed a claim during the month of March, 2002, in the amount of \$4,913.83 on behalf of their minor daughter, Jean Dodson. Jean Dodson, who was playing keyboard with her high school pep band at State Basketball Tournaments at Pershing Auditorium, allegedly received an electrical shock while adjusting an amplifier which was connected to an extension cord supplied by Pershing Auditorium. Claimants alleged that the extension cord was faulty. This claim has been referred to the insurer for Pershing Auditorium and is **PENDING**.

Lillian Hekl filed a claim during the month of March, 2002, in an unspecified amount for damage incurred to her mailbox as the result of snow removal. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

Jennifer Hatfield filed a claim during the month of March, 2002, in the amount of \$725.75 for damage incurred to her vehicle when it was struck by a StarTran bus. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

Dave and Jayne Christensen filed a claim during the month of March, 2002, in an unspecified amount for damage incurred as the result of a sanitary sewer back-up. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

Charles Yearley filed a claim during the month of April, 2002, in the amount of \$847.03 for damage incurred to his vehicle as the result of an accident involving a Lincoln police vehicle. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

Loretta Crocker filed a claim during the month of April, 2002, requesting return of junk vehicles to her and relief from citations and towing and storage fees. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

Andrea Seuferer filed a claim during the month of May, 2002, in the amount of \$177.00 for damage allegedly incurred to sprinkler system as the result of a street repair project. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

Erik Paik filed a claim during the month of May, 2002, in the amount of \$2,300.00 for damage incurred to his vehicle as the result of an accident involving a Lincoln Electric System vehicle. This claim was reviewed by Lincoln Electric System personnel and has been **DENIED**.

Larry and Connie Gaskill filed a claim during the month of May, 2002, in the amount of \$545.95 for alleged damage incurred as the result of a broken water meter. This claim has been reviewed by this office and has been **ALLOWED** in the amount of \$545.95

Neil and April Kringle and Neil and April Kringle on behalf of their minor child, Blake Kringle, filed a claim during the month of May, 2002, in the amount of \$1,000,000 for damages allegedly incurred when Blake Kringle fell off of his bicycle and into a culvert. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

Laura J. LeFrois and Laura J. LeFrois on behalf of her minor child, Matthew Young, filed a claim during the month of May, 2002, in the amount of \$614.95 for damage incurred to vehicle when it struck an alleged defect in an alley. This claim has been reviewed by this office and has been **DENIED**.

Paul Eckerson filed a claim during the month of May, 2002, in the amount of \$1,123.38 for alleged damages incurred as the result of a sanitary sewer back-up. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

Terry S. Henninger filed a claim during the month of May, 2002, in the amount of \$1,314.61 for alleged damage incurred to vehicle when it struck a boulder setting beside a roadway at Holmes Lake park. This claim has been reviewed by this office and has been **DENIED**.

Ella Banks Barbee filed a claim during the month of May, 2002, in the amount of \$75,000. Claimant alleges that she was wrongfully arrested. This claim has been reviewed by this office and has been **DENIED**.

CLAIMS FILED MAY 16 THROUGH MAY 31, 2002:

Donlynn C. Rice filed a claim in the amount of \$239.54 for damage incurred to her vehicle as the result of an accident involving an Animal Control vehicle. This claim has been **SETTLED** by the Risk Management Office in the amount of \$239.54.

Ruth Evelyn Morris filed a claim in an unspecified amount for injury incurred as the result of a trip and fall on sidewalk. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

Carol Wallace filed a claim in the amount of \$1,990.00 for property allegedly seized when claimant was arrested by Lincoln Police. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

Mohamed A. El-Tabech filed a claim in an unspecified amount alleging that Lincoln Police violated his rights under the "Vienna Convention on Consular Relations Treaty" and that said violation has caused claimant the loss of his freedom. Claimant was arrested by Lincoln Police on June 24, 1984, convicted of first degree murder, and sentenced to life imprisonment at the Nebraska State Penitentiary. This claim has been reviewed by this office and has been **DENIED**.

Christopher J. Colbert filed a claim in the amount of \$2,000 for damage incurred to his vehicle when struck by a fallen tree limb. This claim has been reviewed by this office and has been **DENIED**.

Laurie Drake filed a claim in the amount of \$1,322.10 for medical expenses incurred when claimant was allegedly struck in the head by a shingle which had become dislodged from the roof of the concession/restroom building at Mahoney Park during extreme wind conditions. This claim has been reviewed by this office and has been **DENIED**.

Aaron Peeks filed a claim in the amount of \$97.75 for reimbursement of tow fees, taxicab fee and parking fine. This claim is under review and is **PENDING**.

PENDING TORT LITIGATION:

Weston F. & Betty Benjamin filed a claim during the month of July, 1994, against the City of Lincoln d/b/a Lincoln General Hospital for alleged injuries incurred when a nurse allegedly improperly placed an intramuscular injection in Mr. Benjamin's hip. This claim has been referred to Lincoln General Hospital's insurance carrier. Counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on May 30, 1996. Neil Danberg is the attorney assigned by Phico Insurance Company to undertake the defense of this case for the City of Lincoln d/b/a/ Lincoln General Hospital. On March 16, 2000, District Court Judge Bernard J. McGinn awarded \$872,615 to Weston Benjamin. This case has been appealed to the Nebraska Court of Appeals and is **PENDING**.

Teri and Matthew Juranek filed a claim during the month of June, 1998, in the amount of \$40,000 for alleged damages incurred as the result of an accident involving a Lincoln police vehicle. Council for claimants withdrew his clients' claim and filed a petition in the District Court of Lancaster County on May 25, 1999. Litigation is **PENDING**.

George Sadd filed a claim during the month of February, 1999, in the amount of \$1,000,000 for alleged injuries sustained when he fell while jogging on the Murdock Trail. Counsel for claimant withdrew his client's claim on September 3, 1999, and filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court against Constructor's Inc., County of Lancaster, and City of Lincoln. Defendant City of Lincoln's Motion for Summary Judgment was sustained by the Court and the City has been **DISMISSED** from the lawsuit.

Woo Yol Chung filed a claim during the month of March, 1999, in the amount of \$1,000,000 for injuries incurred while working in the Lincoln-Lancaster County Hall of Justice and Law Enforcement Center. This claim was addressed to the Lincoln City Council, but the claim itself is a claim against the Lincoln-Lancaster County Public Building Commission. Counsel for claimant, by letter of June 2, 1999, asserted that his client has filed a claim against the City of Lincoln. Counsel for Mr. Chung was advised that the alleged claim has not been filed against the City of Lincoln and it was recommended to the Lincoln City Council not to consider the March 2, 1999, letter nor the June 2, 1999, letter. On November 16, 1999, counsel for Mr. Chung filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court against the City of Lincoln, County of Lancaster, Lincoln/Lancaster County Public Building Commission, and Builders, Inc. Litigation is **PENDING**.

The Estate of Rachel Quintana and her children, Catalina Quintana, Thomas Quintana, Randy Quintana, Samuel Quintana, Felisa Quintana, and Victoria Gallegos, filed a claim in the amount of \$500,000 during the month of November, 1999, for damages incurred when Rachel Quintana fell from her wheelchair while exiting a StarTran Handivan. Counsel for claimants withdrew his clients' claim on July 6, 2000, and filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on July 20, 2000. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Sharon and Larry Zweerink filed claims in the amounts of \$250,000 for Sharon Zweerink and \$100,000 for Larry Zweerink during the month of July, 1999, for damages incurred as the result of Sharon Zweerink's fall on a City sidewalk. This claim was reviewed by this office and denial was approved by the City Council on January 20, 2000. Counsel for claimants filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on July 20, 2000. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Gail P. Frasier filed a claim during the month of December, 1999, in an unspecified amount for alleged injury incurred as the result of falling on a sidewalk. This claim was reviewed by this office and denial was approved by the City Council on January 20, 2000. Counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on September 25, 2000. Plaintiff prays for special damages in the amount of \$13,500 and general damages. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Brian Harman filed a claim during the month of October, 1999, in an unspecified amount for alleged injuries incurred as the result of a motor vehicle accident involving a City-owned vehicle. Claimant was a passenger in a vehicle that was rear-ended by a City-owned vehicle. This claim was referred to the City's fleet carrier. Counsel for claimant withdrew his client's claim on October 6, 2000, and filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on October 9, 2000. Plaintiff prays for special damages in the amount of \$2,500 and general damages. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Lori J. Shipferling filed a claim during the month of August, 1997, in an unspecified amount for injury incurred when claimant stepped onto an alleged defective meter vault lid. This claim was reviewed by this office and denial was approved by the City Council on March 16, 1998. Ms. Shipferling filed suit in the Lancaster County District Court against Gale and Carolyn Cook, the owners of the property where the meter vault is located, and the Cooks have filed a Third Party Petition against the City of Lincoln. Pursuant to jury verdict returned on January 28, 2002, judgment was entered in favor of defendants and

against Plaintiff Shipferling. Counsel for Plaintiff filed a motion for new trial, which motion was overruled. On March 27, 2002, Plaintiff filed a notice of appeal to the Nebraska Court of Appeals. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Mark Hundley filed a claim during the month of May, 2000, for damages incurred when he was struck by a rock while riding his motorcycle. Claimant alleges the rock was thrown from a City mowing machine. This claim was reviewed by this office and denial was approved by the City Council on July 31, 2000. Counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on December 1, 2000. Plaintiff prays for special damages in the amount of \$979.92 and general damages. Litigation is **PENDING**.

David E. Hawkins filed a claim during the month of March, 2000, in the amount of \$60,717.03 for alleged damages incurred as the result of a sanitary sewer back-up at his residence at 5336 Knox. Denial of this claim was approved by the City Council on August 28, 2000. Counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on March 2, 2001. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Scott Williams filed a claim during the month of September, 2000, in the amount of \$75,000 for injuries incurred when he fell off bleachers during a Lincoln Lightning football game at Pershing Auditorium. Counsel for claimant withdrew his client's claim and filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on March 15, 2001. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Dale S. Nelson filed a claim during the month of October, 2000, in the amount of \$1,000,000 for alleged damages incurred as the result of a motor vehicle accident. Claimant alleges that the accident was the result of a police pursuit of a vehicle which struck his vehicle. Counsel for claimant withdrew his client's claim on May 2, 2001, and filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on May 3, 2001. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Summer P. Thomason filed a claim during the month of August, 2000, in the amount of \$1,000,000 for damages incurred as the result of a motor vehicle accident involving a vehicle driven by claimant and a vehicle driven by Teresa Zuerlein, a Health Department employee. This claim was referred to the City's fleet carrier and was denied. Denial of this claim was approved by the City Council on March 5, 2001. Counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on May 3, 2001. Litigation is **PENDING**.

David and Doreen Miller, on behalf of their minor child, Dustin Miller, filed a claim during the month of July, 2000, in the amount of \$50,000 for alleged damages incurred as the result of employees of Animal Control allegedly failing to properly mark or address a package which contained the remains of a cat that had bitten Dustin Miller and was being sent by Fed Ex to Kansas State University to be tested for rabies. Subsequently, the package arrived too late and the cat remains had deteriorated in such a manner that it could not be tested for rabies, and thus, Dustin had to undergo a series of rabies shots. Denial of this claim was approved by the City Council on December 18, 2001. Counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on July 25, 2001. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Cindy Schumacher filed a claim during the month of December, 2000, in the amount of \$500,000 for alleged injury incurred when claimant was allegedly struck by a water bottle that was thrown into the stands by a cheerleader at a Lincoln Lightning football game at Pershing Auditorium. Counsel for claimant withdrew his client's claim on August 13, 2001, and filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on August 15, 2001. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Fleming's Flower Fields, Inc. filed a claim during the month of February, 2001, in the amount of \$1,000,000 for alleged damages incurred when Dobson Brothers Construction, while installing a sanitary sewer line, allegedly crossed the easement line on claimant's property and excavated claimant's hibiscus plants. This claim was referred to Dobson Brothers Construction for disposition, and, therefore, the claim against the City of Lincoln was denied. Denial of this claim was approved by the City Council on April 9, 2001. Counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on August 29, 2001. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Sharon Mitchell filed a claim during the month of March, 2001, in an unspecified amount for damages allegedly incurred as the result of a pothole in an alley. This claim was reviewed by this office and denial of this claim was approved by the City Council on June 4, 2001. Counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County Court on September 24, 2001. Plaintiff prays for special damages in the amount of \$4,014.13, general damages, interest, and costs of action. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Jason Blair filed a claim during the month of December, 2000, for injuries incurred as the result of a motor vehicle accident which was allegedly related to a police chase. This claim was reviewed by this office and denial of this claim was approved by the City Council on September 17, 2001. Counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on September 26, 2001. Plaintiff prays for judgment in the amount of \$10,875.23, general damages, and costs of action. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Jody L. Rockenbach filed a claim during the month of December, 1997, in the amount of \$1,478.22 for medical expenses incurred when claimant was a passenger on a StarTran bus that was involved in an accident. The cause of the subject accident was the negligence of the operator of the other vehicle involved in the accident, Richard Lambert. Therefore, the claim was denied and denial was approved by the City Council on February 16, 1999. Ms. Rockenbach filed suit in the Lancaster County District Court against Richard Lambert, and Lambert has filed a Third Party Complaint against the City of Lincoln. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Clinton Brooks filed a claim during the month of March, 2001, in an unspecified amount for alleged damages incurred when he allegedly slipped and fell on ice on the sidewalk in the area of 1400 "O" Street in Lincoln, Nebraska. This claim was reviewed by this office and denial of this claim was approved by the City Council on May 14, 2001. On December 7, 2001, counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court naming as defendants The Hamid Corporation, Crosstown Investment Co., Inc. and the City of Lincoln. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Robert Blankenship filed a claim during the month of December, 2000, for injuries incurred as the result of a motor vehicle accident which was allegedly related to a police chase. This claim was reviewed by this office and denial of this claim was approved by the City Council on September 17, 2001. Counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on December 20, 2001. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Alan Schroeder filed a claim during the month of March 2001, in the amount of \$50,000 for damages allegedly incurred to septic system during a sewer project. This claim was referred to the contractor for processing and therefore the claim against the City of Lincoln was denied and denial was approved by the City Council on August 6, 2001. Alan Schroeder also filed a claim during the month of May, 2001, in the amount of \$2,689.00 for damages also incurred to his driveway and hydrant during the sewer

project. This claim was also referred to the contractor for processing and therefore the claim against the City of Lincoln was denied and denial was approved by the City Council on June 18, 2001. On December 31, 2001, counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court naming as defendants the City of Lincoln, Wilderness Ridge, LLC, Dobson Brothers Construction Company, and S.P. Olson Enterprises, Inc. Litigation is **PENDING**.

Theodore Wilcox filed a claim during the month of May, 2001, in the amount of \$100,000 for alleged injury incurred when he allegedly fell in a hole after exiting a StarTran bus. This claim was reviewed by this office and denial of this claim was approved by the City Council on September 17, 2001. Counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on December 17, 2001. Litigation is **PENDING**.

The Personal Representative for the Estate of Mildred Youngquist filed a claim during the month of May, 2001, in an unspecified amount for alleged damages incurred when Mildred Youngquist fell out of her wheelchair on a StarTran bus. Counsel for claimant filed a petition in the Lancaster County District Court on April 18, 2002. Litigation is **PENDING**.
