

ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 AN ORDINANCE amending Chapter 9.24 of the Lincoln Municipal Code,
2 Offenses Relating to Property, by adding a new section numbered 9.24.220 to provide that
3 it shall be unlawful for any person convicted of violating specified state and local theft
4 offenses twice within the last ten years to pawn or sell any property to a pawnbroker or
5 second-hand jewelry dealer within the City of Lincoln.

6 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

7 Section 1. That Chapter 9.24 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be amended by
8 adding a new section numbered 9.24.220 to read as follows:

9 **9.24.220 Unlawful Sale to Pawnbroker by Person Convicted of Theft.**

10 It shall be unlawful for any person who has been twice convicted of any theft
11 offense within the last ten years under the provisions of the Nebraska Revised Statutes or
12 the Lincoln Municipal Code to pawn any property or to sell property to a pawnbroker or
13 second-hand jewelry dealer within the City of Lincoln. Convictions for the following
14 Nebraska State Statute and Lincoln Municipal Code violations shall constitute theft offenses
15 for the purposes of this ordinance: Violations of Neb. Rev. Stat. §28- 507, Burglary; Neb.
16 Rev. Stat. § 28-511, Theft by unlawful taking; Neb. Rev. Stat. § 28-511.01, Theft by
17 shoplifting; Neb. Rev. Stat. § 28-511.02, Theft of rented or leased motor vehicle; Neb. Rev.
18 Stat. § 28-512, Theft by deception; Neb. Rev. Stat. § 28-513, Theft by Extortion; Neb. Rev.
19 Stat. § 28-514, Theft of property lost, mislaid, or delivered by mistake; Neb. Rev. Stat. §
20 28-515, Theft of services; Neb. Rev. Stat. § 28-516, Unauthorized use of a propelled

1 vehicle; Neb. Rev. Stat. § 28-517, Theft by receiving stolen property; Lincoln Municipal
2 Code §9.24.120, Receiving stolen property; Lincoln Municipal Code §9.24.130, Taking
3 possession of property without consent of owner; Lincoln Municipal Code §9.24.140,
4 Larceny; Lincoln Municipal Code §9.24.150, Shoplifting; Lincoln Municipal Code
5 §9.24.160, Theft of services; and Lincoln Municipal Code § 9.24.185, Unauthorized entry
6 into motor vehicle.

7 It shall further be unlawful for any pawnbroker or second-hand jewelry dealer to
8 knowingly accept, pawn, or purchase property from such a person.

9 Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and
10 after its passage and publication according to law.
