REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To authorize allocation of City's 20% funding contribution for the completion of the Location, Feasibility Study and an Environmental Document on U.S. Highway 6 between Cornhusker Highway and West "O" Street.

D I S C U S S I O N

The State and City desire to further develop the location Study Concepts on U.S. Highway 6 between Cornhusker Highway and West "O" Street, complete an Environmental document as required by the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), and conduct a Location Public Hearing.

This is a ongoing project which began during March 2001, as a Feasibility and Concept Development Study. Additional funding for subsequent phases is identified in the City's 2003-2009 Capital Improvement Program.
