REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To accept and approve an agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska for the 48" and 36" waterline relocation in Ashland at Hwy 6 and Hwy 63. City Project No. 700789, State Project No. SS-66-6(1006).

D I S C U S S I O N

The State is planning to extend Hwy 63 to the South of the intersection with Hwy 6. In order to do this they will need to place a substantial quantity of fill in order to build the road. This fill will be placed over two of the main water supply lines to the City of Lincoln. The lines are not designed to carry this extra loading. Hence the need for the relocation project and increased design parameters for the new piping. The State is reimbursing the City for 100% of the relocation expenses of the 36" line and 82% of the 48" line.
