REASON FOR LEGISLATION: Replacement of a truck dock on South 7th Street between “L” and “M” Streets.

D I S C U S S I O N

The Department of Public Works and Utilities has received a request for a use of public right-of-way for the replacement of an existing truck dock along the east side of South 7th Street between “L” and “M” Streets. This action would allow the owner improved access to the west side of their building. This request complies with Chapter 14.54 of the Lincoln Municipal Code.

From comments received there are no public utilities in conflict with this proposed dock. However the City of Lincoln Wastewater Division states that Meadow Gold Dairies possibly has a private sanitary sewer line in or along this area. Upon approval of this use of right-of-way the applicant will be required to apply for any building or other applicable permits prior to beginning construction.

The Department of Public Works recommends approval of this request. This use of right-of-way will occupy 367 square feet, more or less.
