This is more efficient, in that it avoids backups at the entrances and allows adult patrons to be age-checked and wristbanded at the same time they purchase drink tickets.

Applicant also requests a waiver from wristbanding every adult. The event takes place throughout the day, including a Friday lunch hour, and numerous adult patrons do not wish to consume alcohol at those times. Wristbanding non-drinkers at those times imposes delays and inconvenience on them. Applicant will wristband all adults who wish to consume alcoholic beverages. Alcoholic beverages must be purchased with drink tickets; cash is not accepted at the bars. No alcohol is served to anyone without a wristband, regardless of apparent age, and event security will enforce this.

- d.) NLCC Rule 013.03B to the extent that the number of security personnel shall be the number of off-duty uniformed Lincoln police officers as agreed upon between Applicant and the City of Lincoln. Since this event is held on a city street, the City of Lincoln requires that off-duty Lincoln police officers be used for security and an appropriate number of officers is determined between Applicant and the Lincoln Police Department.
- e.) NLCC Rule 013.03F to the extent that double fencing or 6-foot chainlink fence is not required, and that single-row 4 to 5-foot plastic snow or plastic link fence be

acceptable. The event takes place on paved city streets and sidewalks, and double-row fencing would unduly narrow the site while also being difficult to erect on pavement. Applicant has found that the single-row 4 to 5-foot plastic snow or plastic link fence it has used on this site for festivals since 1992 is adequate for perimeter security. Applicant has not experienced problems with persons trying to pass alcohol over the fence. Celebrate Lincoln does not have an admission fee, so there is no incentive for "gate-crashing."


