**APPLICANT:** Public Works and Utilities

**REASON FOR LEGISLATION:** To provide authority for the Mayor to execute an agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads, so that Federal Funds can be obligated and used for this citywide Safety Improvement project. Durable Crosswalk Marking Project, Various locations, State Project No. STPP-5231(12), CN 12741; City Project #701909.

## **D I S C U S S I O N**

The City of Lincoln proposes to install Durable Markings(3M LP 1500) for crosswalks on concrete surfaces along various major arterial streets with relatively high Average Daily Traffic(ADT), in accordance with federal guidelines and requirements. The City has tested various pavement marking materials on concrete surfaces with little success of material retention, except liquid polyurea (3M LP 1500) applications. The State agrees to reimburse the City, using Federal Safety Funds, for 80% of the actual eligible cost up to a maximum of \$176,000. The scheduled completion of this Safety Improvement project is fall 2004.

**POLICY OR PROGRAM CHANGE:** No

**COST OF TOTAL PROJECT:** Estimated Construction and Construction Engineering at \$220,000 (State Project No. STP- 5231(12))

**SOURCE OF FUNDS:** Federal Safety Funds - 80% of the eligible costs upto a maximum of \$176,000.

**CITY:** \$44,000 (SO) Street Construction funds.

**NON CITY:** \$176,000 Federal funds.
