<p>Discussion (Including Relationship to other Council Actions)</p> <p>The City of Lincoln, in conjunction with the Saline Wetlands Partnership continues to prioritize and acquire saline wetlands in a targeted area for protection and restoration. The NRD has the expertise to manage this fragile community and are willing to do so as part of a larger complex of Saline Wetlands. This wetland was acquired with NET Funds and Section 6 funds. It is a 61.16 acre site with both upland that is currently being cropped and will be planted with native grasses and wildflowers. The wetland areas are prime Salt Creek Tiger Beetle habitat.
