

RESOLUTION NO. A-_____

1 WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department of the City of Lincoln
2 proposes to apply for financial assistance from the Nebraska Game and Parks
3 Commission from the Recreational Trails Program for the purpose of constructing a 10
4 foot wide, 893 foot long connector trail between the Rock Island Trail and the Tierra/
5 Williamsburg Trail and an eight foot wide, 938 foot long trail connection between 27th
6 Street and the Tierra neighborhood; and

7 WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln has available and will supply its share of the
8 project cost from previously identified funds in the CIP Budget; and

9 WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln has the financial capability to maintain the
10 completed improvements in a safe and attractive manner for public use; and

11 WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln wishes to express its support for the project and
12 its willingness to commit to the cost of maintenance of the completed improvements in a
13 safe and attractive manner for the public.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of
15 Lincoln, Nebraska:

16 That the City of Lincoln hereby expresses its support for the application being
17 made by its Parks and Recreation Department to the Nebraska Game and Parks
18 Commission for financial assistance from the Recreational Trails Program for the
19 purpose of constructing the connection between the Rock Island Trail and
20 Williamsburg/Tierra Trail and the connection between 27th Street and the Tierra
21 neighborhood.

1 The City of Lincoln will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race,
2 color, age, religion, handicap, sex, or national origin in the use of the proposed project
3 acquired or developed pursuant to the application for financial assistance. The City of
4 Lincoln certifies that it has the financial capabilities to maintain the completed

7 facilities accessible to the handicapped.

8 The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the
9 Parks and Recreation Department for inclusion with the application to the Nebraska
10 Game and Parks Commission.
