

RESOLUTION NO. A-_____

1 WHEREAS, on May 11, 2004 the Lincoln City Council adopted Flood Standards
2 for New Growth Areas; and

3 WHEREAS, the Flood Standards for New Growth Areas identified the regulation
4 of Floodprone Areas as determined by hydrologic and hydraulic studies completed by
5 the City of Lincoln or other governmental agency, or other acceptable source as
6 approved by the City where this is the best available information; and

7 WHEREAS, the City is a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)
8 cooperating technical partner and has contracted with a consulting firm to develop
9 revised floodplain mapping for Stevens Creek as a component of the Stevens Creek
10 Watershed Basin Planning Study which is a cooperative effort of the City and the Lower
11 Platte South Natural Resources District;

12 WHEREAS, a licensed engineer has certified that the work was completed in
13 compliance with the provisions contained in FEMA's Guidelines and Specifications for
14 Flood Hazard Mapping Partners, and the City has submitted a Flood Insurance Rate
15 Map Physical Map Revision application to FEMA for Stevens Creek and its tributaries;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, identifying the best available information is in the public interest and
18 intended to protect the public health, safety, and welfare.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of
20 Lincoln, Nebraska:

1 That the Stevens Creek Floodprone Areas, as shown on Attachment "A", are
2 hereby adopted as the best available information and shall be used in any circumstance
3 where the Floodprone Area is more restrictive than the FEMA Floodplain until such time
4 as the City of Lincoln adopts the revised FEMA Floodplain Map for Stevens Creek.
