REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To provide authority for the Mayor to execute an agreement with the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads so that the project is eligible to receive Federal Funds.

DISCUSSION

The current Capital Improvement Program identifies construction of the Antelope Valley "P" and "Q" Street Bridges Project to occur in fiscal 2005-2007. The identified funding sources for construction of the project include Highway Allocation Funds (SO) and Federal Aid - Urban Area Projects Funds (PC).

Federal funds will be utilized for that portion of the project construction and construction phase engineering services that are not eligible work items associated with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineer's Antelope Creek Flood Control Project. In accordance with federal requirements, the local sponsors cannot utilize other sources of federal funds as part of their required local match for the Antelope Creek Flood Control Project.

The schedule for this project has been developed to allow construction of the new bridges at "P" and "Q" Streets to begin in Fall of 2005 with substantial completion of the project in November of 2006. The work on the new bridges at "P" and "Q" Streets will include construction of temporary pavement around the bridge construction area and phased construction at the approach roadway to maintain traffic flow along these streets during construction of the project.

A public information meeting for the Antelope Valley Projects was held on June 24, 2003. At the meeting no one spoke in opposition to the "P" and "Q" Street Bridges Project.
