

ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 AN ORDINANCE amending Section 4.54.010 of the Lincoln Municipal Code
 2 relating to the Community Forestry Advisory Board by modifying the membership
 3 requirements to eliminate the provision that at least one voting member must reside in each
 4 of the City Council districts; and repealing Section 4.54.010 of the Lincoln Municipal Code
 5 as hitherto existing.

6 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

7 Section 1. That Section 4.54.010 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be amended
 8 to read as follows:

9 **4.54.010 Community Forestry Advisory Board; Created.**

10 There is hereby created an eleven-member advisory committee to be known as the
 11 Community Forestry Advisory Board. The Mayor shall appoint, with the approval of the
 12 City Council, seven individuals who shall be citizens of the City of Lincoln to serve as voting
 13 members of said Board. ~~At least one voting member shall be from each of the four council~~
 14 ~~districts as established by ordinance.~~ It shall be desired, but not required, that Board
 15 members reside in different locations throughout the City of Lincoln, to create as broad a
 16 geographical representation as possible.

17 Of the seven individuals initially appointed, three shall initially be appointed for a
 18 term of three years; two shall be initially appointed for a term of two years; and two shall be

1 initially appointed for a term of one year. Thereafter, all appointments to the Board shall be
2 for a term of three years unless such appointment is to fill an unexpired term, in which case
3 such appointment shall coincide with the expired term to be filled. No voting member may
4 be appointed for more than two consecutive terms, and any voting member of the Board may
5 be removed for good cause by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council.

6 In addition to the seven voting members provided above, the City Arborist, the City
7 Engineer, the chair of the Park and Recreation Advisory Board, and the chair of the Lincoln-
8 Lancaster County Ecological Advisory Committee shall serve as non-voting ex officio
9 members.

10 Section 2. That Section 4.54.010 of the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto
11 existing be and the same is hereby repealed.

12 Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after
13 its passage and publication according to law.
