

RESOLUTION NO. A-_____

1 WHEREAS, on May 10, 2004 the Lincoln City Council adopted Flood Standards for
2 New Growth Areas; and

3 WHEREAS, the Flood Standards for New Growth Areas identified the regulation of
4 Floodprone Areas as determined by hydrologic and hydraulic studies completed by the City
5 of Lincoln or other governmental agency, or other acceptable source as approved by the
6 City where this is the best available information; and

7 WHEREAS, the City is a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)
8 cooperating technical partner and has contracted with a consultant to develop revised
9 floodplain mapping for Southeast Upper Salt Creek as a component of the Southeast Upper
10 Salt Creek Watershed Stormwater Master Plan which was a cooperative effort of the City
11 and the Lower Platte South Natural Resources District;

12 WHEREAS, a licensed engineer has certified that the work was completed in
13 compliance with the provisions contained in FEMA's Guidelines and Specifications for
14 Flood Hazard Mapping Partners, and the City has submitted a Flood Insurance Rate Map
15 Physical Map Revision application to FEMA for Southeast Upper Salt Creek; and

16 WHEREAS, identifying the best available information is in the public interest and
17 intended to protect the public health, safety, and welfare.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln,
19 Nebraska:

1 That the Southeast Upper Salt Creek Floodprone Areas, as shown on Attachment
2 “A”, are hereby adopted as the best available information and shall be used until such time
3 as the City of Lincoln adopts the revised FEMA Floodplain Map for Southeast Upper Salt
4 Creek.
