| Acceptance of one piece of sculpture into the City Public Art Collection | 1/17/06 | Expand the City's sculpture collection and support the revitalization and beautification of the Haymarket |

DETAILS

Reason for Legislation

The proposed resolution authorizes acceptance of donation of one (1) piece of sculpture into the City Public Art Collection for display on publicly owned property for a ten year period.

Discussion (Including Relationship to other Council Actions)

The following artwork has been offered to the City for display at the associated location:

"Listen" a sculpture by Lincoln artist Adam Tourek, owned by the Lincoln Haymarket Development Corporation (LHDC), for display on public property at the northern terminus of 8th Street, at the entrance to the greenspace to the east of the Haymarket Pedestrian Bridge that will be developed as a City park.

Listen was commissioned by the Lincoln Haymarket Development Corporation in partnership with the University of Nebraska - Lincoln's sculpture class. The LHDC is now offering the piece to the City for display at the 8th Street location.

Listen was selected in a juried competition by a panel of judges that included representatives from the Haymarket, Downtown Lincoln, the Lincoln Arts Council, the University Fine Arts Department and the State Arts and Humanities Council.

The piece was reviewed by the Historic Preservation Commission and the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board. Both groups recommended accepting the piece, with conditions (see below).

The LHDC has agreed to a Conditional Acceptance agreement that requires them both to maintain the piece for a ten year period and to remove the sculpture from public property at any time the City requests during the ten year period.

DETAILS

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board recommended accepting this piece into the City collection for a period of ten years. During that time, if the piece requires any maintenance, such maintenance would be the responsibility of the Lincoln Haymarket Development Corporation. At the end of the 10 year loan period, the LHDC can either apply for an extension of this loan arrangement or will be responsible for deaccessioning this piece. The LHDC subsequently agreed to these conditions (see attached letter), which were codified in the attached Conditional Acceptance agreement developed by the City law department.
