The Public Works and Utilities Department has received a request for a use of public right-of-way for the construction of a railing and wheelchair ramp at 700 'O' Street. This is an existing dock in the Haymarket area which is planned for modification to allow handicap access to the restaurant at this site. The area for reconstruction is approximately 41.5' by 9.5'.

Public Works has no objections to this request. However the applicant will be required to contact Diggers Hotline of Nebraska prior to commencing any construction activities. The applicant will also be required to obtain any and all other permits to construct the railing and ramp.

This use of right-of-way will occupy approximately 395 square feet.
