

RESOLUTION NO. A-\_\_\_\_\_

1           WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln intends to apply to the State of Nebraska  
2 Department of Roads for financial assistance from the Transportation Enhancement  
3 Program for the purpose of constructing the Jamaica North Trail – Phase II a  
4 pedestrian/bicycle trail located on the abandoned Union Pacific Railroad approximately  
5 4th and Calvert Streets to 4th and J Streets; and

6           WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be \$773,685 of which the Great  
7 Plains Trails Network will provide \$273,685, and the Transportation Enhancement  
8 Program grant request will be \$500,000. No City tax dollars will go into construction of  
9 this trail; and

10           WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln wishes to express its support for the project and  
11 its willingness to commit to the cost of operation and maintenance of the completed  
12 facility in a safe and attractive manner for the public.

13           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of  
14 Lincoln, Nebraska:

15           That the City of Lincoln hereby expresses its support for the application being  
16 made by Lancaster County to the State of Nebraska Department of Roads for financial  
17 assistance from the Transportation Enhancement Program for the purpose of  
18 constructing the project described above and known as the Jamaica North Trail – Phase  
19 II and its commitment to the on-going maintenance of the trail.

1           The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the  
2 Parks & Recreation Department for inclusion with the application to the State of  
3 Nebraska Department of Roads.
