Petitioner is requesting the re-paving of said alley through a special assessment district. Petitioner sites said alley to be in disrepair and causes safety concerns for ingress and egress. The petitioner has contacted a number of property owners that will be benefitted through the special assessment district and believe the necessary majority of frontage can be obtained for the re-pavement if the district is created.
