Please review and forward the following requests for funding. We reviewed 15 proposals requesting \$77,508. We are recommending funding 9 proposals with the available \$31,000.

	Agency/Program	Amount	Description
1	Homestead Girl Scouts Council: Scouting for Every Girl Everywhere	\$ 2,438	Provides scouting for 75 girls ages 11-18, at the Detention Center and People's City Mission.
2	Big Brothers/Big Sisters: BOAT- Building Our Assets Together	\$ 1,875	Provides matches with children of incarcerated parents.
3	Indian Center, Inc.: PRIDE – Multicultural Primary Prevention	\$ 3,000	Working with 100 Native American Youth and families to reduce truancy and dropout rates.
4	Lincoln Housing Charities: Expanding Horizons	\$ 1,000	Provides summer enrichment for 115 Youth at the Carol Yaokum Family Resource Center.
5	YWCA: Parents Center	\$ 3,750	Provides 25 teen moms tools and education to become self-sufficient.
6	KZUM Radio: "Parents Journal Radio Program"	\$ 3,580	Provides underwriting for this national program on parenting, child development and prevention of "at-risk" behaviors.
7	Lincoln Medical Society Foundation: MAP—Emergency Assistance Fund	\$ 4,500	MAP assists low-income access to medication. Last year they served 3,000 persons.
8	Lincoln Council on Alcohol & Drugs: "I Have Hope Campaign"	\$ 5,000	A 24 month public education campaign to increase acceptance of substance abuse treatment.
9	Voices of Hope: Family Violence Support and Therapy Groups	\$ 5,857	Support on-going groups serving 350 women in 2007; and adding art therapy for children.
