Appendix "C" and made a part hereof by reference, are hereby established as the hourly pay grade
schedules for employees of the City of Lincoln whose classifications are assigned to pay ranges
which are prefixed by the letter "C".

Section 4. That as of August 23, 2007, the schedules of annual, monthly, bi-weekly,

and hourly pay range equivalents, attached hereto and marked Appendix "D" and made a part hereof
