**APPLICANT:** Public Works & Utilities

**REASON FOR LEGISLATION:** To provide authority for the Mayor and Finance Director to appropriate City funds for a multi-year Joint Antelope Valley (JAVA) Project. The Project is shown in the City's 2007-2013 Capital Improvement Project as Project No. 780104, Antelope Valley O Street Bridge and Roadway.

## **D I S C U S S I O N**

The current Capital Improvement Program identifies construction of the Antelope Valley "O" Street Bridge Project to occur in fiscal 2007-2008. The identified funding sources for construction of the project include City and State Funds.

This project consists of building a new bridge and the associated roadway on O Street between 21<sup>st</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> Streets. The bridge will be built on the existing street with the channel excavation under the bridge to be done by the Corps of Engineers in 2008. Traffic will be detoured around the site on a temporary road to the north of O Street. Construction of the O Street Bridge is scheduled to begin in September 2007 with final completion in the Fall of 2008.

Federal funds will be utilized for that portion of the project construction and construction phase engineering services that are not eligible work items associated with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineer's Antelope Creek Flood Control Project. In accordance with federal requirements, the local sponsors cannot utilize other sources of federal funds as part of their required local match for the Antelope Creek Flood Control Project.
